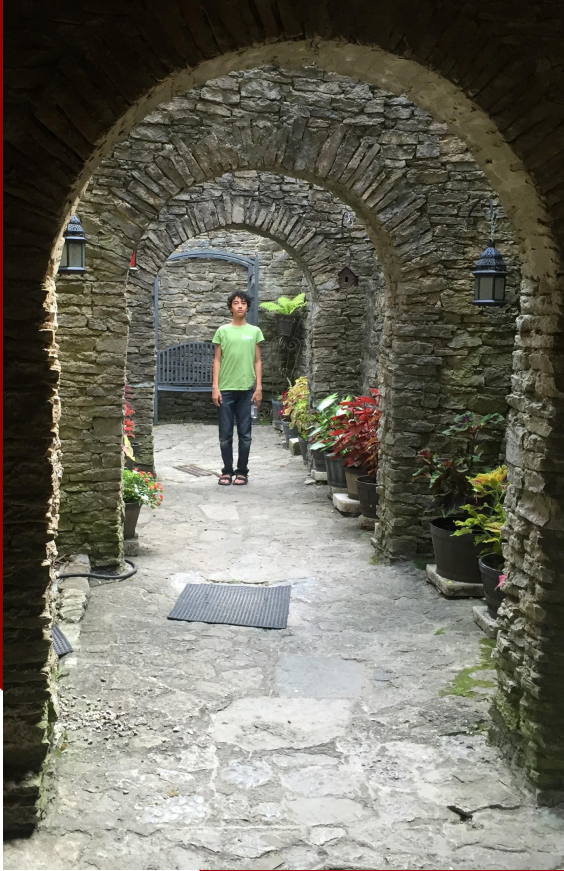


Valen Wilcox
